

Note on Parochial Church Council nominations

PCC members have a significant, prayerful responsibility for the local mission of the Church, contributing to decisions about its strategic direction and use of resources.

PCCs are charities and so PCC members are also charity trustees. They therefore have to accept ultimate responsibility for directing the affairs of the PCC, ensuring that it is financially solvent and well-run, and delivering its charitable outcomes, with the overall aim of growing disciples of Christ in Brighton and Hove and for the world.
